

2020 Wrenshall Volleyball Spectator Policy

VARSITY VOLLEYBALL GAMES

According to the Minnesota Department of Health, fans and spectators will now be admitted and allowed at Volleyball contests for 2020. Only family members of volleyball student athletes and designated game workers will be admitted in the facility. The maximum fan capacity allowed for indoor contests set by the Minnesota Department of Health is 250. Each school will allocate two tickets to their participants' family members. No community members or students will be admitted unless designated by the family.

Season passes will be available to the player's family for home games and will be advance sale so no money will exchange hands at the school. At Wrenshall home games, fans will give their name to the pass checker, and their name will be checked on the admittance list. If their name is on the list, they will be allowed to enter the gym. Any fan not wearing a mask or whose name is not on the admittance list will not be allowed to enter.

All games for both home and away will be live streamed free of charge. The live stream link for games will be provided on the school website. At Wrenshall home games, parents can volunteer as a designated game worker. For road games, there will not be any opportunities for parents to work the contest. In order to work a contest, you must sign up in advance with Mr. Peterson. Workers and officials must be pre-screened before entering the gym. Any worker not wearing a mask or whose name is not on the admittance list as a designated worker will not be allowed to enter.

Indoor attendance capacity at school facilities:

- Student athletes will be allowed 2 spectators at a competition.
- Spectators will enter through the side entrance of the school by the playground.
- Spectators must be separated from the competition by a minimum of 12 feet.
- Spectators must be separated by at least 6 feet between households/spectator groups.
- For indoor events where 12 feet can't be maintained between participants and spectators, participants must be included in the total capacity count.
- If spectators and participants can be clearly separated by at least 12 feet, then participants do not need to be included in the total capacity count.
- Mask use is required by all spectators at all indoor events.
- No more than 250 spectators will be allowed in the gym for an event.
- Essential game/event personnel include: Team members, game officials, and site staff (including ticket-takers/sellers, administrative supervision from both schools, certified medical personnel, announcer, official scorers, and score board operators, etc.) do NOT count toward the maximum number of occupants if they remain separate from the spectator community. Game/event personnel should be limited to the extent possible.

Game worker and Team procedures

- Game workers will enter through the side entrance of the school by the playground.
- Visiting teams will enter through the pool door.
- The visiting school AD/coach will be responsible for pre-screening their coaches and athletes before leaving for the contest.

- Locker rooms will not be available for either team.
- Home and Visiting teams will need to show up to the contest dressed in game attire.
- When the JV/Varsity team is not competing, those athletes will be allowed to social distance on the bleachers to watch the game.
- **NO ONE WILL BE ADMITTED TO THE GAME WITHOUT A MASK OR FACE COVERING**

Home Team Live Stream: There will be a designated location for the home team's live stream camera. This area will be taped off. Both JV and Varsity contests will be live streamed free of charge for family and friends to watch on the school's designated facebook page. There will be a link to this page on the home page of the school's website.

Visiting Team Live Stream: The visiting team will also be allowed a designated location to live stream the games.

Home Fan Season Passes: Each player's family will be sold season passes. The cost of a volleyball season pass is fifty dollars. Players can bring cash or a check made payable to WHS to the main office. Once a pass is purchased the player will be allowed four names on the admittance list. Even though there are four names on the list only two spectators per player may enter the game. Spectator names will be added to the admittance list at the time of payment.

Visitor Fan Tickets: The visiting team will be selling passes to their fans as well. They will also be allowed two fans per player to enter the game. The visiting admittance list must be sent to jzywicki@isd100.org by noon the day before the game.

- **NO ONE WILL BE ADMITTED TO THE GAME WITHOUT THEIR NAME BEING ON THE ADMITTANCE LIST.**

*When Wrenshall is the visiting team, the Wrenshall fans will enter the visiting gym free of charge if their name is on the admittance list. The Wrenshall admittance list will be sent to the host school the day before the game.
